Brenda Kay McGowan Jefferson, 75 years of age, transitioned to be with her Savior on Friday, February 9, 2024. Brenda was born on July 11, 1948, in Tylertown, MS, to the late Jesse and Vivian Magee McGowan. She was one of three children born to her parents. She was educated in the Walthall County School system in MS where she met her high school sweetheart, Mathew Jefferson. She later moved to New Orleans and attended Delgado Community College. In 1975, she began working at United Parcel Service where she began as a delivery driver and worked her way up to Regional District Manager before retiring in 1992.
