“ *Dr. Ed Hager:
Ed was one tough dude. I recall one day he came in for his shift and said that his ankle hurt as he had his lower leg run over by a car at a gasoline station. He had filled up his motorcycle and just as he was leaving another customer just pulled out on him. He didn't have speed up on his cycle and leaned to make a turn away from the automobile and his bike just fell over on him and the other driver ran over his foot/lower leg. For 3 days he complained how his leg hurt so badly; especially when pulling on and off his boots. .
Finally Dr. Bill Holtman (our Circuit Supervisor) and I convinced to go into see a MD as the pain was getting worse. It was a tough sell as he did not like MD's. Turned out he had a broken fibula and a dislocated talus bone (the main supporting bone of the lower leg over the ankle). The hospital surgically repaired it and put him in a plastic covered walking cast. He gimped around the plant for several weeks until his leg was finally healed.
